We think of rosé as a wine for the back porch on a sunny day. I think rosé should be respected as an incredibly diverse food wine that comes in so many colours, flavours and styles.

2022 Sapling Yard Wines "Sur Lie" Canberra District \$75 Sur Lie - meaning left on lees - this Rosé is made from Mourvèdre from the Hilltops region. Aromas of red cherries, violets, thyme and smoked meats, barrel fermented for 8 months, the Sur Lie Rosé has texture, complexity and body.

2023 Horner Wines Cabernet Sauvignon Rose Central Ranges \$62 Cabernet from the Central Ranges region. Sweet raspberries with a subtle floral lift. The palate is filled with strawberries and cream with soft dry finish.

2021 James Edwards Wines Shiraz Rose Hunter Valley \$88 Generous yet understanded Rose from certified organically farmed Shiraz grow in the Ablington Vineyard. This is all perfumed aromatics, red fruits, and a hint of savoury spice. The finish is lovely, long, and dry.

Cold fermented, no fining or filtration, bottled within 14 weeks of picking. Strawberries and watermelon. The palate is clean and savoury, exploding with watermelon and finishing long and clean with crisp white strawberry acidity.

2021 Johansen Wines Gamay Rosé Tumbarumba \$68 Bursts with fruit flavour, ripe raspberries, strawberries and cream. Ends with a fresh finish and leaves you just wanting to take another sip.

2021 Triniti Cotes du Provence Sainte-Victoire Provence, France \$72 Elegant light pink robe with dark purple reflections. In the nose, flavours of white peach and citrus notes (orange blossom). In the mouth, fresh and soft attack. Very nice and subtle combination of lychee, citrus and rose aromas.

Spotlight on: Canobolas Smith – Orange – A pioneer of the Orange Wine Region.

Alchemy is probably the reason I'm in the wine industry today. I'll never forget tasting that remarkable balance of Cabernet Sauvignon, Franc and Shiraz. The vineyard and winery were established by the Smith family in 1986. After a lengthy search for a site with the ideal combination of climate, soil and aspect to be able to create great wine, their search led them to the northern slopes of Mt Canobolas near Orange NSW. The vineyard sits at an elevation of 850 metres, on a north-facing site with rich volcanic soil and excellent air drainage. Now, it's owned by Jonathon Mattick and it's a pleasure to showcase his first vintage alongside these historic wines!
