Champagne & Other French Tipples

I am unapologetic about my love of Champagne. To me, nothing in the world has more care, consideration, consistency & reaches for perfection like Champagne.

NV Champagne Abelé 1757 Brut Reims \$135

Third Oldest Champagne House of Reims. Pioneer of the Disgorge method and Champagne once served on the Titanic (literally once served). 40% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 25% Pinot Meunier. 3 years on lees.

NV Champagne Abelé 1757 Brut Rosé Reims \$180

A symphony of fruity aromas, especially strawberry and raspberry. The aromas carry over onto the palate, which is smooth with all the fruitiness and finesse one would hope for in pink Champagne.

NV Champagne Abelé 1757 Blanc de Blancs Reims \$195

Overtones of white flowers, hawthorn, and acacia. The Chardonnay expresses itself beautifully in this cuvee. Lean the palate with plenty of finesse and freshness. Reminiscent of mineral overtones.

NV Champagne Lombard Brut Nature Grand Cru Epernay \$145

50% Pinot Noir Grand Cru (Ambonnay, Verzenay) 50% Chardonnay Grand Cru (Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, Chouilly, Avize, Cramant) The chardonnays growing on the chalky soils of the Côte des Blancs, bring finesse and sharpness. The Pinot Noirs from the southern part of the Montagne de Reims, on clay-limestone soils, express fullness. The barrel ageing is used to reveal the subtleties of these great terroirs thanks to gentle oxidation.

NV Champagne Nathalie Falmet Brut Cotes des Bar \$148

50% Pinot Noir, 30% Chardonnay and 20% reserve wines. Nathalie controls every aspect of her wine and she was the first woman to have the title Vigneron and Oenologist. She is to this day one of the very few women in Champagne to carry out both jobs simultaneously. And she does it with innervation and with dazzling results.

NV Champagne Lombard Extra Brut Rosé Epernay \$180

40% Pinot Noir Premier Cru (Semiers, Cumières) 50% Chardonnay Premier Cru (Grauves, Vertus) 10% Pinot Noir Grand Cru (Verzenay). No fining. Ageing 6 to 8 months in vats. Ageing 6 to 8 months in barrels. 40% of the blend with MLF blocked

2008 Champagne Lombard Brut Nature Grand Cru Epernay \$435

2008 was a great vintage, especially for the Chardonnays. They are in a large majority in the blend to maintain the typical freshness of this vintage: the grapes were showing high acidity and excellent phenolic maturity. The Pinots Noir from Ambonnay bring the body, necessary so that the wine represents the best of his vintage.

2009 Abelé 1757 Sourire de Reims Brut Reims \$365

For Sourire de Reims Champagne, Maison Abelé 1757 selects the finest Cru Chardonnay and Pinot Noir parcels from the Cote des Blancs and Montagne de Reims. Only wines from exceptional years are deemed worthy of inclusion in the blend. 10 years on lees.

2008 Abelé 1757 Sourire de Reims Pinot Noir des Riceys Rosé Reims \$395

Intense and Flavourful and from an incredible vintage. During vinification, the grapes are macerated for only a short period (36-48 hours), imparting unique character to this exceptional Rosé Champagne. 10 years maturing on lees

NV La Traditionelle Biodynamic Gamay Sparkling Beaujolais \$90

Light rosé colour, sparkling bubbles. Fresh, small red fruits aromas, well integrated acidity.

He harvests the grapes for his first vintage in 1864. Today, Tyrrells is a member of Sustainable Winegrowing Australia and continues to make incredible wine from their estate!

Spotlight on: Canobolas Smith – Orange – A pioneer of the Orange Wine Region.

Alchemy is probably the reason I'm in the wine industry today. I'll never forget tasting that remarkable balance of Cabernet Sauvignon, Franc and Shiraz. The vineyard and winery were established by the Smith family in 1986. After a lengthy search for a site with the ideal combination of climate, soil and aspect to be able to create great wine, their search led them to the northern slopes of Mt Canobolas near Orange NSW. The vineyard sits at an elevation of 850 metres, on a north-facing site with rich volcanic soil and excellent air drainage. Now, it's owned by Jonathon Mattick and it's a pleasure to showcase his first vintage alongside these historic wines!

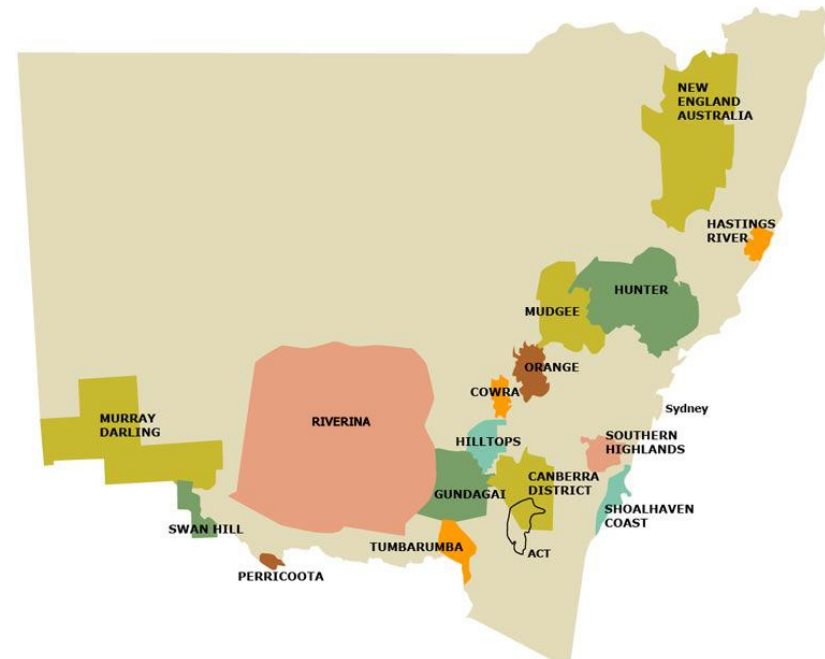
